## **New Imaging Locations, New Physicians Set to Improve Outpatient Radiology Services**

**DAYTON** – Kettering Health Network has purchased two thriving medical imaging centers and will retain four physicians from those centers beginning Tuesday, Dec. 21.

Dayton Medical Imaging (DMI) South, located at 7901 Schatz Pointe Drive in Centerville, and DMI North, 113 National Road, Vandalia, are preparing to join KHN next week. With over 40,000 procedures a year for both sites, they will immediately be KHN's most active outpatient medical imaging sites. The DMI North site will be the Network's first location in Vandalia.

"The radiologists at these centers have a great reputation in the Dayton market for their excellent service and taking time with the other doctors," said Mark Rita, Director of Radiology for Grandview Medical Center. "This will be a huge physician satisfier because these four doctors will read for all of our outpatient medical imaging sites, so referring physicians and their office staff will have the ability to consistently speak with the same radiologists."

The DMI radiologists joining KNH are Jeffrey, D. Cushman, DO; Bradley A. Weber, DO; Wilfredo J. Suntay, PhD, MD; and Mark J. Sulek, DO. The two centers also have a total of 25 clinical and office staff which will be retained when KHN takes control of the sites.

DMI North offers X-ray, Dexa scan, mammography, ultrasound, CT and MRI imaging services. DMI South provides the same services, plus digital mammography and PET scan capabilities.

“We are excited about expanding the Network’s reach with two outstanding medical imaging centers,” said Nancy Robie, Director of Business Development for Grandview Medical Center. “The continuity we gain with these four radiologists will help all of our outpatient imaging centers, and their availability will be appreciated by our referring physicians when they have follow up questions for a radiologist.”
